Background

The purpose of this Addendum is to provide additional information to support the individual code protocols following the announcement by the Queensland Government of further restrictions for the Greater Brisbane area (LGAs of Brisbane, Moreton Bay, Ipswich, Redlands and Logan) effective from 6pm Monday 11 January 2021 until 1am Friday 22 January 2021.

Racing Queensland has determined that, unless otherwise stated, the requirements set out in this Addendum will apply at all race meetings to be conducted in the South East Queensland region from the Sunshine Coast and below for the dates specified.

Face Masks

All Essential Racing Personnel at race meetings are required to carry a face mask at all times and must wear the face mask whilst in the parade ring/mounting yard area, and at any time, both indoors or outdoors, when they cannot physically distance from others. Barrier/mobile/starting box and catching pen attendants are required to wear a face mask whilst on track. Jockeys and drivers are permitted to remove their face masks whilst racing.

In line with Queensland Health's requirements, anyone who was in the Greater Brisbane area on or since 2 January 2021 should follow the same mask wearing requirements/principles wherever they are now. This may apply to racing participants who are now outside of the Greater Brisbane area.

Temperature testing on arrival

Temperature testing of Essential Racing Personnel on arrival at race meetings will be conducted during this period. The testing process and requirements will be as outlined:

- Each person is tested upon arrival at the racecourse by a Medical Officer;
- A verified test within the normal parameter (under 37.6) is required before the person can enter the racecourse;
- If a person records an elevated temperature, the person will be given the opportunity to have a further temperature test up to 15 minutes following the first test; and
- If the person's temperature remains elevated the person is not permitted to enter the racecourse. The person is required to leave the racecourse and should be advised to seek medical advice through 13HEALTH. For jockeys, a medical clearance to the satisfaction of the QRIC may be required before riding again.

Core Racing Area Access

Access to the Core Racing Areas at race meetings is as per the current code protocols except that Owners are not permitted to access the Core Racing Areas at race clubs within the Greater Brisbane area during this period.

Officials' and Participants' rooms

Race clubs are to ensure that the rooms/facilities to be used by Stewards and other officials, Jockeys and Drivers etc. are of sufficient size to meet the following requirements:

- 1 person per 4 square metres;
- Smaller rooms/facilities up to 200 square metres, 1 person per 2 square metres up to a maximum of 50 people;
- Physical distancing of 1.5 metres between people.
